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Dear Patient:

You have received this letter because you have requested that we acquire your standard blood labs from your primary care, medical doctor. Please present this letter to your doctor so that they may be sure to order enough information to be useful for our analysis.

The following tests are considered comprehensive enough for most patients who would like to be evaluated for contributing factors to sub-optimal health. We may request additional “add-on” tests or specialty labs. These add-on and specialty tests are commonly unavailable from your primary care physician and are typically handled through our office. For a more comprehensive listing of tests offered, please request our Laboratory Test Price Sheet.

A Standard Health Evaluation Panel includes the following tests:

Hepatic Function Panel

Albumin, Alkaline Phosphatase, SGPT, SGOT, Direct Bilirubin, Total Bilirubin, Total Protein.

Lipid Panel

Triglycerides, Total Cholesterol, HDL, LDL, VLDL, HDL/LDL ratio

Renal Function Panel

Albumin, BUN, Creatinine, Calcium, Carbon Dioxide, Chloride, Glucose, Phosphorus, potassium and sodium.

Electrolyte Panel

Carbon Dioxide, Chloride, Potassium and Sodium

Comprehensive Metabolic Panel

Albumin, alkaline phosphatase, SGPT, SGOT, bilirubin., BUN, BUN/Creatinine ratio, calcium, carbon dioxide, chloride, creatinine, globulin, glucose, potassium, total protein and sodium.

Thyroid Panel

TSH, T-4, T3 Uptake, FTI

Iron Elements

Serum Iron and as add-ons if TIBC, Ferritin Iron may be recommended.

Cardiovascular Elements

As add-ons: C-Reactive Protein, Fibrinogen, Homocysteine, NMR Lipoprofile, PLAC Test and Apolipoprotein Assessment may be recommended.

Your primary care medical physician can use the following codes to order your bloodwork from LabCorp (Laboratory Corporation of America) or simply order their own panel which includes all of the following constituents.

12 Hour Fasting / Avoid Exercise / Min. 1 week off all supplements / Consult M.D. regarding prescription drugs. Prescription drugs may influence lab results.
